Please note, that this is the only meeting that requires registration and will not allow dial in, this is to maintain election eligibility.

2. An expedited election will be held at this meeting to elect a PTA President, A PTA Treasurer and a Recording Secretary, A Vice President and a Corresponding Secretary. All nominations will take place at the meeting. The only qualification to run for an office is that you are a parent or guardian in the school. If a member runs unopposed they will be elected with one vote. If there are more than one nomination for a position, there will be a vote held. If there is more than one candidate for any one position the candidates will have an opportunity to speak to introduce themselves. Our staff member will verify that you are a parent/guardian of a child at the school.

3. An election will be held for three SLT seats. All nominations will take place at the meeting.

The only qualification to run for an SLT seat is being a parent/guardian of a child in the school.

If there are three unopposed candidates, they will be elected by one vote each. If there are more than three candidates, a vote will be held.

If there are more than three candidates each candidate will have an opportunity to speak.
