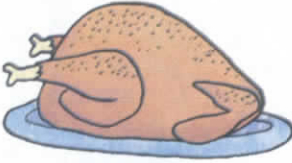

THANKSGIVING FEAST PROJECT



You have been chosen to organize a Thanksgiving dinner! With it coming soon, you need to start gathering ingredients based on what you want to make. You will need to plan for a main dish, sides, and desserts. You will need to figure out how much money you will need to purchase everything for the evening.

STEP 1: GUEST LIST

Create a guest list of yourself and 4 other people that will be attending your dinner. This can include family, friends, or celebrities. Write your own name for number one!

STEP 2: MAIN DISH

Pick a main dish to serve at your dinner. All meats are sold by the pound. Once you find the meat (or vegetable if you're vegetarian..) you want to serve, find the price per pound. You will multiply that number by the number of people coming to your dinner, so each person will get a pound to eat. So if turkey was \$5.35 a pound you would multiply \$5.35 by the number of guests.
